FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET

Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?

A: One vote by a designated voter, one (1) per unit

Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?

A: Please see Governing Documents for full disclosure.

Declaration Section 12. Use Restrictions

Each unit shall at any time be occupied by only one family, its servants and guests, as a residence and for no other purpose.

Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium document on the leasing of my unit?

A: Please see Governing Documents for full disclosure.

Declaration Section, 13. Leasing of Units

The Minimum lease term is thirty (30) consecutive days.

Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?

A: Assessments are due on or before the first day of each quarter. The amount of the quarterly assessments for 2025 is: \$1,820.00. The above amounts include funding of reserves.

Full details can be found in the 2025 Budget.

Q: Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are my assessments?

A: YES, Cross Creek Master Association, each unit shall be entitled to one vote. The association fees are included in the quarterly fees paid to the Condo Association. Please contact 239-768-1166 for more information.

Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
