A. ANNUAL MEMBERS MEETING: The annual members meeting shall be held at the office of the Association, or such other location as shall be designated by the Board of Administrators, at one o'clack p.m. Eastern Standard Time on the fourth Saturday in January in each year for the purpose of electing Directors and of transacting any other business authorized to be transacted by the members; provided however if that day is a legal holiday, the meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next day.

The unpaid assessment for the remaining portion of the calender year for which the amended assessment is made shall be due upon the date of the assessment if made on or after July 1, and if made prior to July 1, one half (1) of the increase shall be due upon the date of the assessment and the balance of the assessment upon the next July 1. The first assessment shall be determined by the Board of Directors of the Association.
